enjoy a good reputation across the continent, with African airlines and international humanitarian organisations making extensive use of the Mi-8/17 family. Russian Helicopters will be promoting the upgraded Mi-171A2.

The company will also demonstrate the new light multirole Ansat, available in various modifications to suit local operating conditions, and its possibilities for the commercial civil aviation market. They claim the Ansat is an advanced solution to Africa's growing demand for light utility helicopters. Versions of the Ansat can be used by passenger and cargo transport companies, medical and rescue services, and police and other law enforcement agencies. The Ansat's key advantages are ease of operation and maintenance.

On 20 September Russian Helicopters and Denel Aviation will hold a joint conference, 'Maintenance and repair of Russian made helicopters. New opportunities for regional operators'. The conference will cover the planned presentation of new helicopters for the African market (Mi-171A2 and Ansat), as well as a report on the development of a regional after-sales care network for Russian helicopters.

Russian Helicopters will also showcase the medium multirole Ka-32A11BC, which was certified by the EASA in 2009 and is now being supplied to buyers on all continents (two are already operational in North Africa).

Thanks to its coaxial rotor system, the Ka-32A11BC can hover with a high degree of precision and is highly manoeuvrable – both qualities are essential for complex construction operations, such as installing power lines

in remote and challenging terrain. Another competitive advantage is the Ka-32A11BC's fire-fighting capability using horizontal water cannons. A helicopter fitted out for fire-fighting operations will be on show at AAD.

In addition to civilian helicopters, the joint Russian Helicopters/Oboronexport display will showcase the Mi-35M – a multipurpose military transport helicopter capable of day/night operation in even the most adverse weather conditions. The Mi-35M is designed to destroy armoured vehicles, provide covering support for infantry, transport airborne troops, evacuate injured personnel, and transport cargo in its cabin and on external slings.

The flying display is always a highlight for many of the aviation public and photographers. The actual flying programme will only be released on the first of the public days but it is expected to include a strong presence from the SAAF as the host nation airforce.

The SAAF is expected to fly a SAAB Gripen, BAE Hawk, and the Silver Falcons Aerobatic team, as well as the Rooivalk helicopter.

At time of writing it is not certain what American participation in the flying display will be, but it is hoped that Boeing will bring a C-17 and it is expected that Lockheed Martin will bring a C-130J as part of its on-going efforts to sell this aircraft for South Africa's maritime patrol need.

Airbus is not expected to demonstrate its A400M or 235 / 295 medium transports. The A350XWB airliner visited South Africa six weeks before the AAD and its tight certification programme does not permit it to

return for AAD.

From the general aviation side, flying displays will range from paramotors and gyrocopters to business jets.

"For the public airshow days, prepaid tickets will be sold at an affordable price (R60 adults and R50 children under 12 whilst pensioners receive a R10 discount). To encourage attendance there will be lots of entertainment for the whole family, static displays of aircraft, trucks and armoured vehicles and an entertainment park for children", Vhongani Shumba says. ☺
